Whereas, people with lupus face a lifetime of living with the unpredictable and sometimes fatal affects that are debilitating, and has no known cause and no known cure; and

Whereas, there is an urgent need to increase awareness in communities worldwide of the devastating impact of lupus; and

“Lupus Awareness Month”

and urge all citizens to show your support for the millions of Americans whose lives are affected by lupus by wearing purple on Friday, May 18, 2018
