CHARGE(S): Violation of a domestic violence injunction

WHEN: 11/05/2017 @ 1146 hrs.

WHERE: 819 Darby Lane

NARRATIVE: Officer Davis responded to 819 Darby Lane in reference to a subject refusing to leave the residence. Upon arrival contact was made with the resident and Gregory Kirshy. The resident advised that Kirshy dropped off some items and was then asked to leave. Kirshy refused several requests from the resident and became belligerent. Another family member was able to exit the residence and call law enforcement. During the investigation Kirshy refused to leave the property upon law enforcement request. It was found that the resident had an active domestic violence injunction against Kirshy and that Kirshy's actions were in violation of the conditions on that injunction. Kirshy was placed under arrest for violation of a domestic violence injunction and transported to the Hernando County Jail. Kirshy was held at the Hernando County Jail under a no bond status.
